REGISTRATION FOR THE 2016-2017

Thank you to all the parents who have registered their children using the on-line system.

It is very important that all parents complete the on-line registration.

By registering your child, you are helping the school district plan for the correct number of teachers needed for next school year.

The directions needed to complete this process were provided in the letter you received from the District Office. The fees can be paid by either check or by credit card through the District 34 website.

If you are re-applying or feel you may qualify for the District Free/Reduced Meal Program, you do not have to pay the fees at this time. The application for this program will be mailed to all District 34 parents in early August.

Please Note: There is a new addition to on-line registration that is critically important for parents to complete. Federal regulations now require school districts to seek permission to send non-emergency phone calls, which includes canceling school due to winter weather.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO CHECK THE BOX THAT YOU AGREE TO RECEIVE THESE TYPES OF PHONE CALLS WHEN ADDING YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION.

Complete the online registration form. Visit www.glenview34.org, select “Parents” and then select “Online Registration.” You will need to enter your PowerSchool User Name and Password that you created when setting up your account.

If you do not remember your User Name/Password, click the “Forgot Username or Password?” link and follow the directions to recover your User Name or Password.

If you have not created an account in PowerSchool, click the “Create Account” tab, then the “Create” button. You will be prompted to fill in your name, email, etc. Then, under the “Link Students to Account” section, you will need the ID and Key (that was mailed to you) in order to link your student with the parent account you are creating:

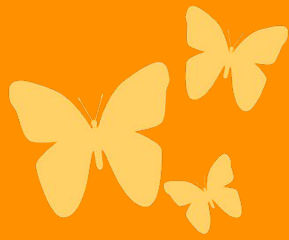

Summer Food Safety Tips

- ❖ **Bring Hand Soap-** keeping your hands clean is the best way to prevent the spread of disease. Wash your hands before and after handling food
- ❖ **Don't let food sit out-** foods should not stay out of refrigeration for longer than 2 hours to prevent bacteria growth.
- ❖ **Pack Ice-** Ice keeps food cold and prevents bacteria growth. It's also great to store leftovers in the cooler on the way home
- ❖ **No coolers in the trunk-** keep coolers in the air-conditioned part of the car when the weather is hot.
- ❖ **Keep raw meats separate-** Keep cooked foods, produce and raw meats in separate packages when storing and transporting.
- ❖ **Use thermometer-** food thermometers make sure the food you are serving is safe. Cold foods should be served at 40 ° or colder and hot food should be held at 140° or above. Go to www.foodsafety.gov for recommended cooking temperatures for food.
